AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE 4.70.040 PERTAINING TO  
SOLID WASTE COMMISSION

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1. That Anchorage Municipal Code 4.70.040 is amended to read as follows:

4.70.040 Solid waste commission

There is established a solid waste commission consisting of [FIVE] seven members. The director of municipal solid waste services shall be the executive secretary and the technical advisor to the commission.

The commission shall:

- A. Conduct public hearings on matters pertaining to refuse collection, solid waste, hazardous waste and recycling rates or regulations, and, after such hearings, recommend to the mayor and the assembly adoption of the [COLLECTION] rates or regulations.
- B. Review solid waste department policies and practices.
- C. Conduct public hearings on various topics relative to refuse collections, solid waste, hazardous waste and recycling services when deemed advisable by the commission.
- D. Review annually the solid waste department's budget and operations
- E. Provide recommendations as to any necessary expansion or improvement of the solid waste services department.
- F. Perform such other duties as the mayor and the assembly may from time to time refer to the consideration of the commission.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
