Subject: REVISIONS TO ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 (ANIMALS)

The attached revised Title 17 (Animals) is submitted for Assembly consideration and approval.

The current Title 17 underwent a major revision and was adopted by the Municipal Assembly in July 1997. In January 1998, the Animal Control Advisory Board (ACAB) began taking public comment on the six month old code. Based on public comment, the board recommended reorganization of the code and many changes. At the request of the ACAB and other community groups, the municipality contracted with an animal law consultant to rewrite Title 17. The ACAB utilized a portion of the consultant's work in developing a draft. The draft was forwarded to the municipality in legal review format in May 2000. Throughout this process, the board took public comment at regular meetings as well as at numerous meetings dedicated to discussing proposed revisions. The Municipal Attorney's Office provided review of the draft and a revised copy was submitted to the board for comment in June 2001. The board and the municipality worked together to finalize the draft now in front of the Assembly, and recommends its adoption.

Introduction of Title 17 is essential at this time to allow for solicitation of additional public comment. The Department of Health and Human Services plans to notify the public of the introduction to the Assembly and request additional comments by accomplishing the following:

- Notification to community councils. ACAB members are committed to attending community council meetings to address the code revisions.
- Posting in the Journal of Commerce and the Anchorage Daily News.
- Posting on the municipal web-site with an attachment of the proposed revisions.
- Solicitation of comments from various animal groups such as the Anchorage Animal Clubs Coalition, Friends of Pets, Alaska Humane Society, Alaska SPCA, and others.
- Additional public comment on the proposed Title 17 will be scheduled at public meetings in October.

THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES RECOMMENDS THE ASSEMBLY SET A PUBLIC HEARING IN LATE JANUARY, 2002 FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REVISED ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 (ANIMALS).
