**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 28.40
BALLOTS, TO INCLUDE THE FACSIMILE SIGNATURE OF THE MUNICIPAL CLERK.**

WHEREAS, the Assembly amended and approved AO No. 2001-43 on February 27, 2001, which deleted the facsimile signature requirement from AMC 28.40.010 because of what was understood to be space constraints on the new ballots, said ordinance to be effective on January 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing samples provided by the consultant it appears the facsimile signature can be provided on the ballot forms; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 28.40.010E. is hereby amended to read as follows: *(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out)*


28.40.010 Form.

E. Each ballot shall bear the words "Official Ballot," [AND] the date of the election, and a facsimile signature of the municipal clerk.
