THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Anchorage Municipal Code section 8.30 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. follows:

8.30.050 False information [REPORTS].

- Α It is unlawful for any person to:
 - report to any police officer, district attorney, prosecutor, assistant 1 district attorney, or other official of any public law enforcement or prosecution agency that a felony or misdemeanor has been or will be committed, knowing such report to be false.
 - 2 knowingly give false information to any public servant
 - with the intent of implicating another in an offense; or a
 - b. concerning the person's identity while the person is
 - under arrest, detention, or investigation for a crime; or 1.
 - being served with an arrest warrant or being issued a 11 citation.
 - knowingly register, make, render, report or give false information to <u>3.</u> any public servant that an incident dangerous to life or property
