AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE ORDINANCE NO. 2000-132(S) (AS AMENDED) TO AUTHORIZE THE LEASE OF ADDITIONAL SPACE IN THE CITY HALL BUILDING AND APPROVE THE NEGOTIATED TERMS

WHEREAS, Anchorage Ordinance No. 2000-132(S) (As Amended) authorized the consolidation of the existing leases of City Hall into one lease and approved the terms and conditions of a new 25 year lease with an option to purchase; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to the Municipality to lease the remaining 3,200 square feet, more or less, located on the first floor, some of which is currently occupied by other tenants; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Anchorage Ordinance No. 2000-132(S) (As Amended) is hereby amended as follows: Section 1.

- The square footage covered by the City Hall lease is increased an additional 3,200 square A. feet, more or less, from 106,244 to 109,417 square feet.
- The Annual Rent for 1,600 square feet of the additional space shall be at the lease rate B. authorized by AO 2000-132(S) (As Amended).
- For the remaining 1,600 square feet of additional space in the building (now occupied by two C. other tenants), the Municipality will pay a specified market rate at the termination of the existing tenancies.

Anchorage Ordinance No. 2000-132(S) (As Amended), and as amended by this Ordinance, Section 2. is hereby ratified and confirmed.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Section 3. Assembly.
