This design was approved by the 15 School Board on January 8, 2001. 16 17 The School Board approved the selection of Kumin Associates, Inc. to be the Architects 18 of Record on August 14, 2000 and the Assembly approved this selection on August 15, 19 2000 (AM 781-2000). 20 21 AO NO. 2000-106(S) requires a description of the proposed school site; school building 22 and building program; the projected student population; the total construction budget and 23 the funding source; the projected project schedule; and any known neighborhood impacts, 24 comments, reactions, which reflect potential impacts of the school building on the 25 26 neighboring community. These responses follow: 27 The Denali Replacement School will be constructed on the school's existing 4.7-acre 28 downtown site, located south east of the intersection of "A" Street and 9th Avenue. Due 29 to the site limitations, a portion of the school will be two-story. The existing programs 30 will continue at the replacement school. These include: Intensive Needs, Local 31 Neighborhood, and the Montessori Alternative programs. The projected student 32 population at completion of construction is 403 students. The capacity of the new school will 33 be 550 students. 34 The Conceptual Design is based on the Districtwide Educational Specifications for 35 Elementary Schools adopted by the School Board on November 20, 2000, and the 36 project-specific supplement to these specifications approved by the School Board on 37 38 January 8, 2001. 39 On April 4, 2000 Anchorage voters approved \$11,730,000 in total funding for the 40 41 replacement of the Denali Elementary School. 42 Construction of the school is anticipated to begin in 2002 and be completed in 2003. 43 44 Attached is a set of Conceptual Plan design drawings. 45 46 47 attachment 48 sl
