A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY TO GRANT A TWENTY-FOOT (20') WIDE ELECTRICAL EASEMENT WITHIN EAGLE RIVER COMMONS PARK, TRACT R-2, REGIONAL PARK UNIT NO. 3 SUBDIVISION, LOCATED NEAR BUSINESS PARK BOULEVARD AND REGENCY DRIVE IN EAGLE RIVER, TAX #050-101-35

WHEREAS, improvements within Eagle River Commons Park, Tract R-2, Regional Park Unit No. 3 Subdivision require electrical service provided by Matanuska Electric Association, Inc. (MEA) in order to meet the needs of the Department of Cultural and Recreational Services: and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the electrical service to Eagle River Commons Park, MEA requires a twenty-foot (20') wide electric easement for the purpose of installing electrical service to park facilities; and

WHEREAS, the subject easement is found to be of no substantial value to the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

SECTION 1. That the Administration is authorized to grant the requested electrical easement to MEA in the following location:

Within Tract R-2, Regional Park Unit No. 3 Subdivision, according to Plat Number 83-379 filed in the Office of the District Recorder, Anchorage Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, a twenty foot (20') wide easement centered on underground primary and secondary electrical lines necessary to serve the Municipality of Anchorage facilities on said Tract R-2. The locations of the lines and facilities are shown on the Engineering sketch attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
