A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY TO GRANT A FIFTY-FOOT (50') 1 WIDE UNDERGROUND UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS A PORTION OF KINCAID 2 PARK LOCATED WITHIN SECTION 5, T12N, R4W, S.M., ALASKA, TAX #010-411-16 3 4 5 Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation WHEREAS, the 6 Administration (FAA) requires an underground utility easement for improvements to the 7 Digital Airport Surveillance Radar (DASR) site located within Kincaid Park; and 8 9 WHEREAS, FAA requires a fifty-foot (50') wide underground utility 10 easement for the purpose of installing fiber optic cable and electrical service to the DASR 11 site from Ted Stevens International Airport property; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the proposed use of the easement would not have a material 14 impact on the long-term appearance of Kincaid Park; and 15 16 WHEREAS, FAA has proposed plantings and vegetation enhancement to 17 protect the area's aesthetic and recreational value; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the subject easement is found to be of no substantial value to 20 21 the Municipality. 22 NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves 23 24 SECTION 1. That the Administration is authorized to grant the requested 25 underground utility easement to FAA in the following location: 26 27 Parcel A: A strip of land located within surveyed Section 5, T12N, R4W, Seward 28 Meridian, Alaska, herein described as Parcel A, being 50 feet wide, lying 25 feet 29 left and 25 feet right of the following described line: 30 31 Commencing at the C-N-SW 1/64 corner of surveyed Section 5, T12N, R4W, 32 Seward Meridian, Alaska, from which the N-S 1/64 corner bears N 89° 41' 46" W. 33 1318.91 feet; thence N 89° 41' 46" W, 523.78 feet along said 1/64 line, to the 34 POINT OF BEGINNING of this parcel being described; thence 87.66 feet along a 35 curve concave to the east, having a chord bearing of N 06° 59' 00" W, a chord 36 length of 86.69 feet, a delta of 29° 32' 39" and a radius of 170.00 feet, to the point of 37 tangency; thence N 07° 47' 19" E, 282.86 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 38 108.37 feet along a curve concave to the southeast, having a delta of 41° 23' 37" 39 and a radius of 150.00 feet, to the point of tangency; thence N 49° 10' 56" E, 154.52 40 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 190.42 feet along a curve concave to the 41

northwest, having a delta of 43° 38' 26" and a radius of 250.00 feet to the point of tangency; thence N 05° 32' 30" E, 376.97 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 159.37 feet along a curve concave to the southeast, having a delta of 36° 31' 30" and a radius of 250.00 feet to the point of tangency; thence N 42° 04' 00" E, 305.28 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 138.98 feet along a curve concave to the west, having a delta of 79° 37' 54" and a radius of 100.00 feet, to the point of tangency; thence N 37° 33' 54", 321.49 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 30.62 feet along a curve concave to the northeast, having a delta of 35° 05' 20" and a radius of 50.00 feet, to the point of tangency; thence N 02° 28' 34" W, 93.49 feet plus or minus to the south boundary of the Ted Stevens International Airport. The side lines of said "Parcel A" to be extended or shortened to terminate at the said 1/64 line and the said south airport boundary.

Containing 112,604 square feet or 2.585 acres more or less, as shown on Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
