A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$2,368,420) FROM THE FUND BALANCES OF THE FOUR MAJOR OPERATING FUNDS TO COVER THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH DEBT SERVICE ON THE JANUARY 2000 TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

Section 1. That the sum of Two Million Forty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$2,046,300) is appropriated from the Areawide SA (101) Fund Balance to Non-Departmental to cover costs associated with debt service on the January 2000 Tax Anticipation Notes;

Section 2. That the sum of One Hundred Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$108,950) is appropriated from the Fire Service Area (131) Fund Balance to the Anchorage Fire Department to cover costs associated with debt service on the January 2000 Tax Anticipation Notes;

Section 3. That the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Forty Dollars (\$177,640) is appropriated from the Roads and Drainage Service Area (141) Fund Balance to the Public Works Department to cover costs associated with debt service on the January 2000 Tax Anticipation Notes;

Section 4. That the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$35,530) is appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area (151) Fund Balance to the Anchorage Police Department to cover costs associated with debt service on the January 2000 Tax Anticipation Notes.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
