postponed entirely **AR NO. 2001-** 39 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING HB 92 WHICH WILL INCREASE THE DISTANCE BETWEEN AN ESTABLISHMENT WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AND A SCHOOL OR CHURCH FROM 200 TO 400 FEET WHEREAS, underage drinking is a problem throughout Alaska and fuels perpetual alcohol problems that result in widespread harm to Alaska's youth and society; and WHEREAS, alcohol is the illegal drug of choice among children and causes more harm than all other illicit drugs combined; and WHEREAS, many of our community's social, civic, and health problems are associated with alcohol abuse: and WHEREAS, some liquor establishments attract patrons who can be disorderly and it would be best that they do not interact with our children; and WHEREAS, several of our neighboring states have a greater distance requirement than Alaska between schools and churches and liquor establishes - Washington, Oregon, and Utah restrictions are 500 feet or greater; and WHEREAS, by increasing the distance that liquor establishments can locate in proximity to our schools and churches. HB92 will help to decrease our children's exposure and thus their opportunities to use alcohol. NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves: That the Municipality of Anchorage supports HB 92, which will increase the minimum distance between an establishment where alcoholic beverages are sold and a school or church from 200 to 400 feet.
