WHEREAS, numerous studies have confirmed that smoking tobacco products is a major contributor to indoor air pollution, and that breathing second-hand smoke is a cause of diseases such as heart disease, lung cancer, and respiratory problems, even in non-smokers; and

WHEREAS, smoking in workplaces also restricts employment opportunities of non-smoking employees or creates adverse employment conditions, since non-smokers are subject to second-hand smoke; and

WHEREAS, to protect public health and allow for equality of employment opportunities, more restrictive measures on smoking need to be developed and enforced at the local level; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 136, which has been introduced in the Alaska State Legislature, makes clear the intent of the Legislature that local governments are not restricted from enacting stricter laws regulating smoking in public buildings and workplaces in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has recently responded to its citizens' requests for local regulation of smoking in public buildings and workplaces, successfully implementing its "Prohibition of Smoking in Public Places" ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Assembly supports House Bill 136 and encourages the Alaska State Legislature to pass the bill.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the Municipal Clerk forward copies of this resolution to the State Legislature upon passage and approval.
