**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING NATIONAL

WHEREAS, April 20 and 22, 2001, mark the 13<sup>th</sup> annual observance of National Youth Service Day, a national day of service dedicated to recognizing and celebrating individuals and groups of youth age 25 and under for their volunteer service, citizenship, and community contributions; and

WHEREAS, National Youth Service Day is a part of "America's Promise: The Alliance for Youth" which develops community resources such as mentoring and volunteer service opportunities; and

WHEREAS, National Youth Service Day communicates to policy makers, business and community leaders, educators, parents, and young people the idealism and vast potential of organized youth service; and

WHEREAS, Volunteers of America Alaska is coordinating local National Youth Service Day activities and urges schools, churches, community youth programs, civic clubs, and teams to encourage and recognize youth for service activities; and

WHEREAS, local sponsors for National Youth Service Day in Anchorage include the MOA Department of Cultural & Recreational Services, Prudential, AT&T Alascom, UAA Center for Community Engagement & Learning, Alaska State Commission on Community Service, Anchorage Youth Commission, Anchorage YouthServe Action Council, and Volunteers of America Alaska.
