A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING UP TO FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$453,000) FROM THE AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) BALANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A TENTATIVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH LOW INCOME HOUSING PROPERTIES REGARDING REAL PROPERTY TAX APPEALS

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

That the sum of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$453,000) is hereby appropriated to the Finance Department according to the terms of a Tentative Settlement Agreement reached between the Municipality of Anchorage and the Low Income Housing Properties. The Tentative Agreement settles the 1998 and 1999 appeals which are pending before the Superior Court and the 2000 appeal which is pending scheduling before the Board of Equalization, and represents substantial savings for the Municipality in not having to litigate the appeal issues and/or if LIH were to prevail in court or the 1998 and 1999 appeals were remanded to the Board of Equalization.

That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and Section 2. approval.
