**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING JOHN B. "SKIP" EDINGER JR. FOR ALMOST 30 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE
MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE**

WHEREAS, on July 8, 1971, John B. Edinger, Jr., a.k.a. "Skip", began his employment with the Greater Anchorage Area Borough working as an Engineering Technician II in the Department of Public Works, tasked with bringing coordination, organization and structure to the creation of sanitary sewer trunk and lateral improvement districts and the assessment of properties benefiting from the same; and

WHEREAS, in 1978, Skip was promoted to Engineering Technician IV, and in January 1982, Skip and the Anchorage sewer assessment functions were relocated from the Department of Public Works to the Anchorage Water & Sewer Utilities, consolidating with the water assessment office; and

WHEREAS, Skip has been key in coordinating the successful completion and assessment, of scores of water and wastewater special assessment improvement districts throughout the Municipality of Anchorage, professionally and with a unique and personal touch; and

WHEREAS, from the very start, Skip's career history is filled with recognitions, commendations, and appreciations from the public, property owners, contractors, realtors, developers, lending institutions, and the Municipality for superior service, for his keen grasp of assessment issues, practices, explanations and resourcefulness, and an outstanding public dedication and image; and

WHEREAS, these recognitions extend to Skip having been selected the 1972 Alaska State Handicapped American of the Year as a model and inspiration of productivity and innovation in the workplace and society; the 1982 Outstanding Employee of the Year for the Anchorage Water & Sewer Utility; and the 1982 Outstanding Employee of the Year for the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, for nearly 30 years, Skip has been steadfast with his engineering and assessment programs and functions, and loyal to the public of Anchorage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:

JOHN B. "SKIP" EDINGER, JR.

is recognized for his nearly 30 years of service to the Municipality of Anchorage
and the citizens of Anchorage.
