A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF TAX REFUND AS A RESULT OF  
MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 002-031-10-001

WHEREAS, Great Pacific Seafoods was the property holder of record of Real Property Account  
Number 002-031-10-001 on January 1, 1999, and

WHEREAS, during the tax year 1999 the property was assessed based upon the interest  
possessed from The Alaska Railroad, and

WHEREAS, during 1998 the lease held by Great Pacific Seafoods was terminated by the  
Alaska Railroad, and

WHEREAS Great Pacific Seafoods possessed no interest from The Alaska Railroad in  
1999, and

WHEREAS, this assessment constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest  
clerical errors at any time, and

WHEREAS, the refund for the tax year involved totals \$1,539.84 plus interest at 8  
percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,539.84 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to  
the date of payment is hereby refunded.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by  
the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
