A RESOLUTION PROTESTING THE RENEWAL OF THE BEVERAGE DISPENSARY-
TOURISM LIQUOR LICENSE FOR SPENARD PARADISE INN (LICENSE NO. 1139);
TRANSMITTING NOTIFICATION OF VIOLATION OF CONDITIONS TO THE STATE
ALCOHOL CONTROL BOARD; AND FINDING THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE
LICENSED PREMISE TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Police Department has responded to an inordinate number of calls to
the premises and adjacent property;

WHEREAS, the calls often involve crimes of violence, abuse of alcohol, and other crimes of grave
concern to the Municipality and its residents, involving patrons of the premises;

WHEREAS, the neighborhood and the affected community council have repeatedly voiced concerns
with the operation of the premises and the nuisances generated thereby;

WHEREAS, there have been notices of violation regarding the subject premises during the recent
license period; and

WHEREAS, previous Municipal action, including the imposition of conditions, has not substantially
abated the continuing problems associated with the premises; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the renewal is protested for violations of State law, including the provisions of
AS Title 4; violations of Municipal Code, including provisions of Title 8, Title 2 and Title 21; and
violations of municipal conditions imposed upon the license.

Section 2. That the Municipality finds the licensee has violated municipal conditions imposed
upon the license and, pursuant to AS 4.11.480(d), notification is hereby given to the State Alcohol
Control Board for further action by that body.

Section 3. That the Municipality finds that the continued operation of the licensed premises
constitutes a public nuisance which must be abated.
