A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING NINETEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$19,280) FROM THE EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE FUND (601) OF THE FACILITY AND FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT, AS A CONTRIBUTION TO THE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM FUND (607) OF THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING A PROGRAMMER/ANALYST TO DEVELOP PROGRAMS AND ANALYZE DATA USING THE GEMS2000 DATABASE UTILIZED BY FACILITY AND FLEET MANAGEMENT AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENTS

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That a sum of Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$19,280) is appropriated as a contribution from Equipment Maintenance Fund (601) of the Facility and Fleet Management Department, to the Management Information System Fund (607) of the Information Technology Department, to enable the funding and hiring of a Fleet Programmer/Analyst position to manage the vehicle maintenance database (GEMS2000) used by Facility and Fleet Management and Public Transportation Departments.

Section 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
