A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$449,224) TO THE STATE GRANTS FUND (231), DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM THE ALASKA COMMISSION ON AGING TO ASSIST IN THE FUNDING OF COORDINATED TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That a sum of Four Hundred Forty-nine Thousand two Hundred Twenty-four Dollars (\$449,224) is hereby appropriated from the Alaska Commission on Aging to assist in the funding of coordinated transportation services for senior citizens and for people with disabilities within the Municipality of Anchorage.

Section 2. That these funds are appropriated to the State Grants Fund (231), Department of Public Transportation.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
