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## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

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Section 1. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a Restaurant/Eating Place per AMC 21.40.180D.8, located on Muldoon Heights Subdivision, Tract A, meets the applicable standards of AMC 21.50.020 and AMC 21.50.160.

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Section 2. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a Restaurant/Eating Place per AMC 21.40.180D.8., located on Muldoon Heights Subdivision, Tract A; generally located on the east side of Muldoon Road and north of DeBarr Road, is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. 3. A notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorders Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of a final conditional use approval for a restaurant/eating place serving wine and beer in the B-3 District.
- 27 2. 4. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted.
- -3. 5. The use of the property by any person for the permitted purposes shall comply 28 with all current and future federal, state and local laws and regulations including, 29 but not limited to, laws and regulations pertaining to the sale, dispensing, service 30 and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the storage, preparation, sale, service 31 and consumption of food. The owner of the property, the licensee under the 32 Alcoholic Beverage Control license and their officers, agents and employees shall 33 not knowingly permit or negligently fail to prevent the occurrence of illegal 34 activity on the property. 35
  - 1. Liquor sales shall constitute no more than 25% of total gross receipts
  - 2. No alcohol advertisement viewable externally.
