A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ENCOURAGING THE ADMINISTRATION TO PURSUE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP TO RESOLVE SEVERAL LAND USE ISSUES

WHEREAS, the Spenard Community Council and the neighbors living in the Northwood area oppose further expansion of industrial development in their area; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage recognizes that locating street maintenance support on the entrance corridor to the Ted Stevens International Airport is not the highest and best use of Municipal property; and

WHEREAS, the addition of residential housing near Northwood Elementary school would be a desirable use of land/as opposed to additional industrial development in the area; and from a neighborhood viewpoint

WHEREAS, there appears to be a unique opportunity for a public-private partnership to resolve these land use issues through a series of land exchanges, transfers, and rezenes.-

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves

Section 1: That the Administration and the private parties involved are encouraged to work together to develop a mutually beneficial Memorandum of Agreement and provide the Assembly and the public with full details of the proposed transactions.

Section 2: That this resolution is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
