A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE YEAR 2000  
ANCHORAGE CARBON MONOXIDE ATTAINMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage violated the national ambient air quality standard for carbon monoxide in 1996, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 mandated that Anchorage achieve compliance with the carbon monoxide standard by December 31, 1995, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) required the State of Alaska to revise the Anchorage element of the State Implementation Plan (SIP) to achieve compliance with the standard before December 31, 2000, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage is delegated responsibility for air quality planning within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, an air quality attainment plan has been prepared that demonstrates that Anchorage accomplished the carbon monoxide emission reductions necessary to attain the national ambient air quality standard by the year 2000 attainment deadline, and

WHEREAS, the the Anchorage Metropolitan Transportation Study (AMATS) Citizen Air Quality Advisory Committee and AMATS Technical Advisory Committee recommended adoption of the air quality attainment plan, and

WHEREAS, the AMATS Policy Committee approved the plan during their meeting of September 14, 2001, and


WHEREAS, the air quality attainment plan was prepared in accordance with the transportation planning process required under Section 114 of Title 23 of the United States Code and Section 110 of the Clean Air Act, Title 42 United States Code.

NOW THEREFORE , THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

Section 1. That the "Year 2000 Anchorage Carbon Monoxide Attainment Plan" be submitted to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for inclusion in the State Implementation Plan for air quality for submission to the Environmental Protection Agency.
