A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY TO RECOGNIZE THE HORTICULTURE SECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL & RECREATIONAL SERVICES FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENT DURING THE SUMMER OF 2001

WHEREAS, the Municipality's horticulture program produced the 81,000 plants used in different areas of town; 60,000 of which were planted and maintained by municipal staff and 21,000 were planted and maintained by volunteer gardeners; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with Mayor Wuerch's goal to promote public-private partnerships, a number of businesses and civic organizations pledged to contribute, adopt and care for garden sites and hanging baskets such as those donated by Bell's Nursery, Home Depot, Alaska Regional Hospital Nurses, and Municipal Light & Power; and

WHEREAS, all summer long, brilliant colors of red, pink, blue, gold and other hues of the rainbow were seen all over town and appreciated by tourists and residents alike; and


WHEREAS, the community expresses appreciation to all the Horticulture Section employees under the supervision of Bill Robb.
