**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY SETTING FORTH THE PROCESS FOR
REVIEWING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES OF COMMUNITY COUNCILS.**

WHEREAS, district boundaries for community councils have not been comprehensively reviewed since the boundaries were initially established upon unification; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code Section 2.40.040C. states that district boundaries of community councils shall be reviewed at least once every two years upon Assembly or Planning & Zoning Commission initiative or at the request of the Mayor or one or more community councils; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that district boundaries of community councils should be reviewed by the Municipality's Planning staff and Planning & Zoning Commission, and with maximum public input.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: Pursuant to AMC 2.40.040, the Assembly requests a review of district boundaries of community councils in accordance with the remaining sections of this resolution.

Section 2: Upon passage and approval of this resolution, the Planning Director and the Planning and Zoning Commission shall determine an appropriate means of obtaining initial public input on possible changes to community council district boundaries, which may include, but is not limited to, public hearings, town meeting(s) or written submittals.

Section 3: Upon receipt of initial public input regarding potential changes to community council district boundaries under Section 2 above, the Planning Director shall prepare and submit a report and recommendations on community council district boundaries to the Planning and Zoning Commission.

SECTION 4: *see below

Section 4: The Planning and Zoning Commission shall review the Planning Director's report and recommendations, and after conducting a public hearing, recommend any changes in community council district boundaries to the Assembly in the form of an ordinance.

Section 5: Upon receipt of the ⁶proposed ~~an~~ ^aproposed ordinance, the Assembly by ordinance may adjust community council district boundaries in the manner provided by law.

⁷**Section 6:** This resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.

***Section 4:** The Assembly and the Planning and Zoning Commission shall solicit and consider the recommendations of community councils and the Federation of Community Councils concerning changes in community council district boundaries.
