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 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONDITIONAL USE IN THE B-3 DISTRICT FOR A NEW RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE LICENSE PER AMC 21.40.180.D.8, LOCATED ON CALAIS SUBDIVISION, TRACT D-11G AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF DENALI STREET AND CALAIS DRIVE, SITE ADDRESS BEING 3210 DENALI STREET.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a new Restaurant or Eating Place License per AMC 21.40.180.D.8, located on Calais Subdivision, Tract D-11G at the northwest corner of Denali Street and Calais Drive, site address being 3210 Denali Street, meets the applicable provisions of AMC 21.50.020 and AMC 21.50.160.

<u>Section 2</u>. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a new Restaurant or Eating Place License per AMC 21.40.180.D.8, located at Calais Subdivision, Tract D-11G at the northwest corner of Denali Street and Calais Drive at 3210 Denali Street, is approved subject to the following conditions:

A notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorders Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of a final conditional use approval for a restaurant/eating place license in the B-3 District.

2. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted.

The use of the property by any person for the permitted purposes shall comply with all current and future federal, state and local laws and regulations including, but not limited to, laws and regulations pertaining to the sale, dispensing, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the storage, preparation, sale, service and consumption of food. The owner of the property, the licensee under the Alcoholic Beverage Control license and their officers, agents and employees shall not knowingly permit or negligently fail to prevent the occurrence of illegal activity on the property.
