**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING  
THE 55<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF  
ELECTRICAL WORKERS, LOCAL UNION 1547.**

WHEREAS, in 1891, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) was established to serve and protect the safety, welfare and rights of electrical workers who performed dangerous jobs for the sake of their communities; and

WHEREAS, in 1946, the IBEW chartered Local Union 1547, and for over 55 years its members and employer partners have worked to build our great state; and

WHEREAS, IBEW Local Union 1547 has demonstrated its willing participation in the Anchorage community by its generous support of programs such as:

- City of Lights - IBEW volunteers perform the electrical work and provide many hours of free labor and materials to light up the trees and grounds of Loussac Library and Town Square in Downtown Anchorage.
- Christmas in May - IBEW volunteers, with the help of its partner contractors in the National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA), rehabilitate the homes of elderly Anchorage residents and others on fixed incomes who are unable to afford the repairs.
- Safety Bear Buddy - IBEW, along with its utility partners (Alaska Communications Systems, Chugach Electric Association, and Municipal Light and Power) created and established this program which assists children in peril.
- Operation Stand Down - Each year, IBEW members provide the electrical work necessary to set up this program which assists and aids veterans in need.
