AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AT ITS NEXT REGULAR ELECTION ON APRIL 2, 2002 AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE CITIZENS OF ANCHORAGE SHALL URGE THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE TO RESOLVE THE SUBSISTENCE ISSUE BY PLACING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT BEFORE THE VOTERS AT THE NOVEMBER 2002 GENERAL ELECTION

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That a proposition in substantially the same form as appears in Section 2. below, shall be placed on the ballot at the next regular election. The vote on the proposition shall be limited to the qualified voters residing in the Municipality of Anchorage. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved.

Section 2: That the proposition shall be presented in substantially the following form:

Subject: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE CITIZENS OF ANCHORAGE SHALL URGE THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE TO RESOLVE THE SUBSISTENCE ISSUE BY PLACING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT BEFORE THE VOTERS

In spite of the recent Federal takeover of game resource management in Alaska, the issue of subsistence remains unresolved and threatens to divide Alaska. For this reason, the Anchorage Assembly should place the issue of whether the Legislature should address this subject in the form an advisory vote to local voters at the April 2, 2002 Municipal election.

Passage of this ordinance by the Assembly and approval of the proposition by the voters will urge the Legislature to take an important step toward resolving this issue by a vote of the people in November 2002.
