ORDINANCE NO. AO 2002-17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/00 DOLLARS (\$101,625,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF EDUCATIONAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE QUESTION OF AN INCREASE IN THE MUNICIPAL TAX CAP LIMITATION TO PAY ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 2, 2002.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed One Hundred One Million Six Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand and No/00 Dollars (\$101,625,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, site preparation, constructing acquiring, renovating, installing and equipping educational capital improvement projects within the Municipality including, but not limited to, the following

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed One Hundred One Million Six Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand and No/00 Dollars (\$101,625,000), shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid school capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property in the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due

<u>Section 3</u>. An election is to be held on April 2, 2002, in and for the Municipality of Anchorage, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive

a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

EDUCATIONAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$101,625,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay for educational capital improvements within Anchorage and increase the municipal tax cap by an amount of \$1,981,116 to pay for associated annual operations and maintenance costs?

The general obligation bond proceeds will be used to pay costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, site preparation, constructing, acquiring, renovating, installing and equipping educational capital improvement projects within Anchorage. The proposed educational capital improvement projects include, but are not limited to, the following:

Public Sector Economic Effects:

The estimated annual debt service will be \$8,681,163 based on a 20-year amortization schedule at an interest rate of 5.75%.

After completion of the project, the annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$1,981,116.

Private Sector Economic Effects:

The estimated annual debt service will be \$8,681,163 which equates to an estimated property tax increase of 0.5152 mills or \$51.52 per year on \$100,000 of the assessed valuation.

An annual increase in the Municipal Tax Cap Limitation of 0.1176 mills or \$11.76 per \$100,000 of the assessed valuation will result if this bond is approved.

The attached ordinance is being submitted to acquire approval to place a bond proposition on the ballot at the April 2, 2002 election to include a New Eagle River Area High School. The ordinance includes all of the projects submitted by the Anchorage School District in AO 2002-15 with the addition of the School.

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Based on the estimated 2002 assessed valuation, the annual increase in the Municipal Tax Cap to pay for annual operations and maintenance will be \$11.76 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation. The annual increase in taxes to retire the proposed bond indebtedness is estimated at \$51.52 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.
