SUBJECT: AO 2002-65: Mill Levies for 2002

This memorandum transmits the ordinance to establish the mill rate (tax rate) for each of the service areas within the Municipality of Anchorage and the Anchorage School District.

The mill rates for General Government are those needed to support the revised 2002 General Government Operating Budget as proposed in the Administration's first quarter budget revision package in a separate Assembly Resolution. The Anchorage School District mill rate is based on the amount of property taxes required to support the already approved 2002-2003 operating budget.

The following compares the 2001 and 2002 average mill rate for General Government and the School District:

	<u>2001</u>	2002	Change
General Government	9.26	8.90	(.36)
Anchorage School District	8.20	7.65	(.55)

Please note that the General Government 2002 mill rate includes debt service for general obligation bonds approved by voters on April 2nd. The Anchorage School District's 2002 mill rate does not yet include debt service for its approved bonds. The district is expected to submit an amendment that increases the mill rate accordingly, as well as one that increases the amount of 2002 taxes to be collected in order for the school district to "tax to the cap."

These mill rates may change due to other actions taken by the Assembly during its deliberation on first guarter budget amendments. Detailed breakdowns of service area mill levies will be provided at the April 9th work session.
