AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY EXTENDING AND AMENDING THE LEASE OF LOTS 8B & 8C, PORT OF ANCHORAGE SUBDIVISION, TO ANCHORAGE FUELING AND SERVICE COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage leases Lots 8B and 8C, Port of Anchorage Subdivision, to Anchorage Fueling and Service Company (AFSC); and,

WHEREAS, AFSC timely exercised an option to extend the lease term from March 5, 2002 to March 4, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the 1962 lease requires an amendment to update the insurance coverage provisions to the satisfaction of the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, AMC 25.30.020 states that disposal of Municipal land shall be by ordinance only and AMC 25.30.050D states that any extension of a lease shall be treated as a new lease and shall be subject to all provisions of this Code then in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Assembly ordains:

Section 1. That the Municipality of Anchorage is authorized to extend the term of its lease of Lots 8B & 8C, Port of Anchorage Subdivision, located within the Anchorage Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, to Anchorage Fueling and Service Company and amend the lease insurance coverage provisions, upon the terms and conditions summarized in Assembly Memorandum No. AM 387-2002 submitted to the Assembly in conjunction with this ordinance and attached hereto.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Seventh Five-Year Renewal Option of the Lease of Lots 3 8B and 8C, Port of Anchorage Subdivision, to Anchorage Fueling and Service 4 5 Company 6 7 Shell Oil Company and the Municipality of Anchorage (then City of Anchorage) entered into an agreement for Shell to lease Lot 8 (subsequently Lot 8C), Port of Anchorage 8 9 Subdivision, and to lease Parcel B (subsequently Lot 8B) for a ten (10) year period 10 commencing March 5, 1962 and ending March 4, 1972. The lease also provided Shell with eight (8) additional five-year renewal options. Shell exercised its first and second renewal 11 12 options from March 5, 1972 through March 4, 1982. The Municipality consented to an assignment of the lease from Shell Oil Company to Anchorage Fueling and Service 13 14 Company (AFSC) effective July 15, 1981. Thereafter, AFSC exercised the third through 15 sixth renewal options from March 5, 1982 through March 4, 2002. 16 17 AFSC elected to exercise the seventh five-year renewal option, commencing March 5, 18 2002 and ending March 4, 2007. See notification letter, attached hereto. The use of the premises is restricted to the operation of a bulk petroleum distributing plant. This use is 19 20 consistent with an adjacent land lease at the Port of Anchorage. 21 22 Rental rate adjustments are due at the beginning of each renewal option period. The Port 23 notified AFSC of the adjusted five (5) year rental rate on November 27, 2001. The lease 24 rate adjustment was based on rate adjustments for similar Port properties effective in 2001. The following provisions are pertinent to the lease and/or the 7th five-year renewal option: 25 26 27 Anchorage Fueling and Service Company (AFSC) Lessee: 28 29 Location Lots 8B and 8C, Port of Anchorage Subdivision, consisting of 30 approximately 486,033 square feet. 31 32 Rent: \$29,758.33 per month; \$357,100 per year. 33 34 Rental Adjustment: At five-year intervals in conjunction with renewals. 35 Term: 36 Seventh five-year option, beginning March 5, 2002 and ending 37 March 4, 2007. One (1) additional five-year option remains. 38 Services provided by the Lessee: 39 Utilities and maintenance of premises 40 41

In addition, the insurance provisions of the lease, as deleted and replaced in the Consent To Assignment and Amendment of Lease dated May 29, 1981, are amended and revised,

upon recommendation of the Municipality of Anchorage Risk Manager, to recite a minimum amount of general liability insurance coverage, as shown by underlined (added) and bracketed (deleted) text below:

Article Fifteenth

- A. The Lessee shall maintain in good standing the insurance described in subsection B of this section. Before rendering any services under this contract, the Lessee shall furnish Lessor with proof of insurance in accordance with subsection B of this section in a form acceptable to Lessor.
- B. The Lessee shall provide the following insurance:
 - 1. Workmen's compensation and employer's liability coverage as required by Alaska law.
 - 2. General liability insurance including personal injury, property damage and contractual liability and other coverages in such amounts and of such types as may be prescribed by the Municipality of Anchorage to meet Lessee's obligations under that paragraph entitled "Eighth" and in an amount not less than FIVE MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) and not to exceed ONE HUNDRED MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$100,000,000.00) for each occurrence and in the aggregate.
- **The Municipality of** Anchorage shall be named an additional insured on each policy obtained pursuant to this section.

At present, AFSC maintains general liability insurance coverage of \$10,000,000.00, well in excess of the minimum coverage required by this lease amendment.

The Administration requests authority to execute this lease renewal containing the above terms and conditions pursuant to Assembly Ordinance No. 2002-70_____.
