AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 6.10.060 RELATING TO BUDGET
HEARING DATES REQUIRED IN THE HOME RULE CHARTER

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 6.10.060, Budget hearings, is amended to read as follows:

- A.** The Assembly shall hold such public hearings on the proposed operating and capital budget as provided in Charter section 13.04.
- B.** To determine when the Assembly may take final action on the proposed operating and capital budget after its second public hearing, the minimum seven (7) days required by the Charter shall begin on the first calendar day after the second budget hearing and may include the day the Assembly takes final action on the budget.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: **AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE 6.10.060 RELATING TO
BUDGET HEARING DATES REQUIRED IN THE HOME RULE CHARTER**

The Home Rule Charter, in Section 13.04, states that the "assembly shall hold at least two public hearings on the proposed operating and capital budget..." It also provides that one hearing be held at least seven but not more than 14 days prior to the adoption of the budget. The Charter is silent on computation of time.

The purpose of AO 2002-91 is to establish an easily understood method of counting the seven days between the second public hearing and action on the budget. For example, under the new ordinance, the Assembly could conclude its second public hearing on November 19, 2002 and take final action on the budget at its next regular meeting seven days later on November 26, 2002.

Approval of AO 2002- 91 is recommended
