AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.80, ASSEMBLY OFFICE, TO CHANGE
THE NAME TO ASSEMBLY BUDGET AND LEGISLATIVE SERVICES

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That it is the intent of this ordinance that all references to Assembly Office within the Anchorage Municipal Code be amended to read Assembly Budget and Legislative Services.

Section 2: That the Code Revisor shall amend all references in Chapter 2.80 and all other references throughout the Anchorage Municipal Code to reflect the intent of this ordinance.

Section 3: That the Code Revisor shall amend all references to "Director" in Chapter 2.80 to read "Manager."

Section 4: That section 3.20.010, Executive and Administrative Order, which represents the organizational chart of the Municipality of Anchorage is hereby amended to reflect the intent of this ordinance.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
