AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 25.40.030 TO ALLOW FOR A FOURTEEN-DAY MINIMUM PUBLIC NOTICING REQUIREMENT FOR ALL HERITAGE LAND BANK ACTIVITIES REQUIRING PUBLIC NOTICE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.40.030 is hereby amended to read as follows: (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore is not set out.)

25.40.030 Public Notice Procedures.

\*\*\* \*\*

A proposed action shall be noticed by a sign conspicuously placed upon the land proposed for action. The sign shall generally identify the proposed action and include the information specified in section 25.40.030(F). the sign shall be easily visible to the public and be placed upon the land no less than 21 14 days prior to a public hearing by the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission on the proposed action.

\*\*\*

E. All public notices of proposed Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission actions, including public hearings regarding proposed actions, shall precede a hearing before the advisory commission on the proposed action by at least 21 14 days.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

THE PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR HERITAGE LAND BANK ADVISORY COMMISSION ACTIONS FROM TWENTY-ONE TO FOURTEEN

#### **Purpose**

SUBJECT:

The purpose of this request, recommended for Assembly approval by the HLB Advisory Commission on July 17, 2002, is to reduce the amount of lead time required for public noticing of the commission's monthly meeting agendas.

#### Background

The HLB Advisory Commission (HLBAC) has regular meetings dates of the second Wednesday of the month. AMC 25.40.030, Subsections C and E, currently requires a 21-day minimum public notice requirement for its public meetings and hearings on all land exchanges, easements, sales and leases. Most municipal boards and commissions require "reasonable notice" of their regular meetings, unless, like the HLBAC, it is otherwise stipulated (AMC 1.25.015.A and B). Such stipulations vary widely, from seven to thirty-five days, and sometimes vary based upon the nature of the action.

Advertising of public meetings is contracted by MOA with the Alaska Journal of Commerce, a weekly publication. It is noted, per AMC 3.10.005, "the primary method for providing published public notice," as it publishes the Municipal Page that advertises public meetings and hearings for municipal commissions and committees.

The Heritage Land Bank has found that the current code requiring HLB to publish notices of public hearings at least 21 days before in the Alaska Journal of Commerce, requires in addition to the 21 days, compensation for the additional days added to the lead time for the once-a-week publication (on Saturdays), as well as a four-day lead time for the advertising deadline, which is on Tuesdays. As a result, this often places HLB's deadline for providing the next agenda to the Mayor's office 29 days before the meeting. As many of HLBAC's meetings are four weeks (28 days) apart, this often requires that the following month's meeting agenda must be submitted for the advertising deadline the day before the current month's meeting. This has lead to several scheduling conflicts, confusion for the public and occasional backlogs in efficiently conducting HLB business.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HERITAGE LAND BANK TO REQUEST ASSEMBLY APPROVAL TO AMEND ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 25.40 TO ALLOW FOR A MINIMUM 14-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENT FOR HERITAGE LAND BANK ADVISORY COMMISSION PUBLIC MEETINGS AND HEARINGS.

WHEREAS, "It is the mission of the Heritage Land Bank to manage uncommitted municipal land ... to benefit the present and future citizens of Anchorage, promote orderly development, and achieve the goals of the comprehensive plan." (AMC 25.40.010); and,

WHEREAS, current Municipal Code 25.40.030 requires a minimum 21-day public notice publication period for all proposed action items on the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission agenda; and,

WHEREAS, the current Municipal Code requirement often conflicts with the timing of items and issues being addressed from meeting to meeting by requiring notice for one commission meeting to be advertised prior to holding the current meeting; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Municipal Code will bring the Heritage Land Bank in line with other municipal boards and commissions who are routinely required to publish public notice 14 days prior to holding public hearings,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission recommends that the Anchorage Assembly amend AMC 25.40.030 to read:

"E. All public notices of public notices of proposed Heritage Land Bank advisory commission actions, including public hearings regarding such proposed actions, shall precede a hearing before the advisory commission on the proposed action by 14 [21] days."


