AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE SUBLEASE OF A PORTION OF ALASKA RAILROAD LEASE CONTRACT NO. 6434, ALSO KNOWN AS THE SOUTH TIDELANDS, LOCATED IN THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE, TOTALING APPROXIMATELY 8,567 SQUARE FEET, TO ALASKA BASIC INDUSTRIES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Municipality (Port of Anchorage) and Alaska Basic Industries, Inc. (ABI) are desirous to enter into a sublease of a portion of the South Tidelands, located in the Port of Anchorage, now leased by the Municipality from the Alaska Railroad (ARRC) under Contract No. 6434, totaling approximately 8,567 square feet; and.

WHEREAS, the ARRC consents to the Municipality's sublease of a portion of the South Tidelands to ABI: and

WHEREAS, AMC 25.30.020 states that disposal of Municipal land shall be by ordinance only.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Assembly ordains:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Municipality is authorized to sublease a portion of the South Tidelands, located in the Port of Anchorage, within the Anchorage Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, as more particularly depicted on attached Figure 1, to Alaska Basic Industries, Inc., upon the terms and conditions summarized in the Assembly Memorandum submitted to the Assembly in conjunction with this ordinance.

Section 2. Notwithstanding the requirements of AMC 25.30.040, the fair market value of the South Tidelands subleased to ABI shall be valued throughout the term of the sublease, and all extensions of the sublease, as unimproved tidelands.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.



(ABI) presented a written request to the Port of 8 Anchorage to sublease an 8,567 square foot portion of the area commonly referred to as the South Tidelands. The Municipality (Port of Anchorage) leases the South Tidelands from the Alaska 9 Railroad Corporation (ARRC) under ARRC Lease Contract No. 6434 at no fee, based upon other 10 agreements with the ARRC. The initial term of ARRC Lease Contract No. 6434 terminates on 11 August 31, 2027; the Municipality has the option of renewing the lease for two additional 35-year 12 terms, or until August 31, 2097. 13 14 15 The Preliminary Items of Agreement between the parties contained a provision for rent credits. 16 However, after further consideration and agreement by the parties, the Municipality now proposes to 17 sublease a portion of the South Tidelands property at fair market value for undeveloped tidelands. Dear Mr. Finch:

This responds to your letter dated June 28, 2002, regarding the Port's proposed sublease of 8,587 square feet of ARRC's tidelands, covered under ARRC Contract No. 6434, to Alaska Basic Industries.

The Railroad has no objection to the proposed sublease based on the information provided and will execute a final consent upon receipt of the final sublease agreement.

Your paragraph No. 5, Rental Rate Adjustments, in the preliminary agreement, states that the land will be revalued every five years. The land will be valued as undeveloped tidelands. Once the \$55,000 is recovered by ABI and they've basically been reimbursed for the cost of their fill, the land should be valued as uplands rather than undeveloped tidelands. That may be your intent but I thought I would offer the above as information.

When the final sublease is prepared, please forward a copy for our review. At that time, we will execute a Consent to sublease. If you have any questions, please give me a call.

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE PORT COMMISSION RESOLVING THAT THE PORT COMMISSION RECOMMENDS THE SUBLEASE OF A 8,567 SQUARE FOOT PORTION OF ARRC LEASE CONTRACT NO. 6434 TO ALASKA BASIC INDUSTRIES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (Port of Anchorage) leases an area of tidelands from the Alaska Railroad Corporation (ARRC) under ARRC Lease Contract No. 6434 (So. Tidelands Lease); and,

WHEREAS, the Port of Anchorage is the Municipal agency designated with management authority over the So.Tidelands Lease; and,

WHEREAS, Alaska Basic Industries (ABI), in its correspondence of October 16, 2000, requested to sublease an 8,567 square foot portion of the South Tidelands (drawing attached); and,

WHEREAS, subsequent to ABI completing the area fill permitting process through the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, ABI requested a meeting with the Port in mid-May, 2002 to discuss terms of the proposed sublease; and,

WHEREAS, representatives of ABI and the Port developed a <u>Preliminary Items</u> of Agreement For: ABI Sublease of a Portion of the South Tidelands (copy attached) which is subject to review by the Municipal Attorney to insure that the items conform to the Anchorage Municipal Charter and Anchorage Municipal Code; and,

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code 25.50.322 provides that the Municipal Assembly must receive a recommendation from the Anchorage Port Commission prior to approving a lease of tidelands which are under the control of the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Port Commission has reviewed the terms of the <u>Preliminary Items of Agreement For: ABI Sublease of a Portion of the South Tidelands</u> and finds the terms acceptable; and,

WHEREAS, development and fill of the sublease area will contribute to the development at the Port of Anchorage and improve ABI operations in the Port area.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Port Commission resolves:

Section 1. That the Anchorage Port Commission concurs with the proposed sublease to Alaska Basic Industries, Inc. of an 8,567 square foot portion of ARRC Lease Contract No. 6434, as depicted on the attached drawing, and subject to the terms and conditions of the Preliminary Items of Agreement For: ABI Sublease of a Portion of the South Tidelands submitted to the Anchorage Port Commission in conjunction with this resolution and attached hereto.

PRELIMINARY ITEMS OF AGREEMENT FOR: ABI SUBLEASE OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH TIDELANDS

Alaska Basic Industries, Inc. (ABI), in its correspondence of October 16, 2000, requested to sublease an 8,567 square foot portion of the area, commonly referred to as the So. Tidelands, which the Municipality of Anchorage (Port of Anchorage) leases from the Alaska Railroad Corporation (ARRC) under Lease Contract No. 6434. The Port, in its correspondence of October 16, 2000, outlined possible sublease arrangements initial engineering impressions and thoughts to proceed for area fill permitting. Subsequent to ABI completing the area fill permitting process through the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, ABI requested a meeting with the Port in mid-May, 2002 to discuss terms of the proposed sublease.

Requirements:

Any Lease Contract No. 6434 tidelands property which is subleased by the Port to a third party appears to be subject to the following requirements:

- 1. Written consent of the Alaska Railroad Corporation.
- 2. Recommended by the Anchorage Port Commission.
- 3. Approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly
- 4. The sublease is subject to all the terms of ARRC Lease Contract No. 6434.
- 5. Any additional requirements of Anchorage Municipal Code or other requirements, as determined by the Municipal Attorney's Office.

Items of Agreement:

Representatives of the Port and ABI met on May 15, 2002 and arrived at the following Items of Agreement for the proposed sublease of the subject portion of Lease Contract No. 6434 to ABI.

- 1. Area: Approximately 8,587 square feet (Legal Description and engineer's drawing attached)
- 2. Term: Five years
- 3. Renewal Option Periods: Four (4) five-year renewal options not to exceed August 31, 2027.
- 4. Rental Rate: \$1,275 per year (\$1.65 value per square foot X 9% = \$0.149 per square foot)
- 5. Rental Rate Adjustments: Each five years in conjunction with lessee exercising its renewal option. Premises to be valued as undeveloped tidelands.

- 6. Rent Credits: The lessee intends to permanently improve the premises with fill and other improvements at an estimated cost of \$55,000+. In recognition of these improvements, lessee will receive an annual rent credit equal to the annual rental amount up to a total credit amount over the life of the lease of \$55,000.
- 7. Items of agreement contained herein are subject to review by the Municipal Attorney to insure that the items conform to the Anchorage Municipal Charter and Anchorage Municipal Code.
