The Municipality's annual State Legislative Program is an important document that provides the basis for our requests of and interaction with the State legislature.

The intent of AO 2002-174 appears to be to codify when the State Legislative Program is approved by the Assembly and to clarify the fact that the implementation of the program is prescribed duty of the Mayor. We have no objection to either. We do have several concerns about the AO, however.

The codification of the proposed ordinance is in Title 2, Legislative Branch. However, Paragraph B refers to the prescribed duties of the Mayor and should be codified in Title 3, Administration.


The title of the proposed ordinance refers to the <u>Assembly's</u> Legislative Program. We hope this was an oversight in drafting and that, in fact, the intent was to refer to the <u>Municipality's</u> Legislative Program. As is discussed in the sponsor's AM 988-2002, the Municipality's Legislative Program is collaboration between the Assembly and the Administration.

While we support setting a deadline for approval of the program, we suggest the date of January 1 of each year may not be optimal in all instances. By State statute, the legislative session begins on the 3rd Tuesday of the year in the year following a gubernatorial election. For 2003 that is January 21. In other years, it begins on the 2nd Monday of the year.

This year, approval by January 1 gives ample time to publish and distribute the approved program, but in other years, there may not be enough time after approval to publish and distribute prior to the start of the legislative session. We recommend the deadline for approval be not less than 14 days prior to the start of the legislative session.
