In Summer 1998 improvements were made at Ptarmigan Elementary to enclose their classrooms from the open concept school which was built in 1971. Mechanical and electrical improvements were made then along with the installation of a sprinkler system. Bill Tatom was the architect of record for that project. Subsequently, enrollment and membership projections have been increasing up to 150% of capacity in September 2000. This school year three classes of kindergarten students are temporarily attending Chester Valley School to relieve Ptarmigan overcrowding.

Ptarmigan Elementary is located at 888 Edwards Street and was placed on the unsuccessful 2001 bond for design and construction funding to support an addition. A Request for Proposals was issued March 2, 2001. Six firms submitted proposals on March 23, 2001. The proposals were evaluated by the selection committee utilizing the evaluation criteria identified in the Request for Proposal. These criteria consisted of project approach, methods, management, firm's experience, proposed project staff, work ioad and resources. At the completion of this evaluation oral interviews were held with the three top ranked proposers.

The recommended design firm for the project is Porath Tatom Architects. They are an Anchorage architectural firm specializing in educational architecture. They have completed many educational projects over the years to include the District's prototype elementary school.

The School Board on November 12, 2001 approved \$55,000 in forward funding for this project (ASD Memorandum # 101). This initial funding will allow design work to begin and provide increased building committee involvement plus an earlier project bid with the approval of additional funding on the District's recommended 2002 bond package.

This design effort will include the addition of 10 classrooms, a multipurpose room along with renovation of the existing school and site in the areas of the addition. This will provide this attendance area with a full 26 classroom school. Current projections indicate Ptarmigan at 510 membership or 168% of capacity in 2006-07 which support the school addition.
