A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PORT OF ANCHORAGE, TO ENTER INTO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, STATE OF ALASKA, FOR A CADASTRAL SURVEY OF ALTERNATIVE PORT ACCESS ALIGNMENTS AND APPROPRIATING THESE FUNDS TO THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (571).

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Port of Anchorage is authorized to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement with the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, State of Alaska, for a sum not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for a cadastral survey of alternative Port access alignments.

Section 2. That these funds are appropriated to the Port of Anchorage Capital Improvement Fund (571).

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

SUBJECT: \$15,000 Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement For a Cadastral Survey of Alternative Port Access Alignments

The accompanying resolution authorizes a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement between the Municipality of Anchorage, Port of Anchorage, and Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, State of Alaska, and appropriates Fifteen Thousand dollars (\$15,000) for a cadastral survey of alternative Port access alignments.

This project will encompass an initial survey of access alignments for road and rail access around the eastern perimeter of the Port into the Municipal tidelands north of the Port. Once completed, the new access routes will also allow the Port to provide its two major general cargo carriers, CSX Lines LLC and Totem Ocean Trailer Express, Inc., with contiguous real estate leaseholds which will improve their operations, safety and security.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THE ATTACHED RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PORT OF ANCHORAGE, TO ENTER INTO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, STATE OF ALASKA, FOR A CADASTRAL SURVEY OF ALTERNATIVE PORT ACCESS ALIGNMENTS AND APPROPRIATING THESE FUNDS TO THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (571).
