ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S 2002 OPERATING BUDGET, TO THE  
STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR HIGH RISK DRIVER  
DANGEROUS VIOLATION ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.


THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000), is  
appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation &  
Public Facilities, Division of Statewide Planning Highway Safety Office to the State  
Categorical Grant Fund (231) for High Risk Driver Dangerous Violation enforcement.

Section 2. That the sum of THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000), is  
appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151),  
Anchorage Police Department's 2002 Operating Budget as a contribution to the State  
Categorical Grant Fund (231).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage  
and approval

Subject: Appropriation from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, of a Dangerous Violation High Risk Driver Enforcement Grant. (\$60,000)

The Municipality of Anchorage has received a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, Division of Statewide Planning Highway Safety Office for increased enforcement of High Risk Drivers & Dangerous Violations. This grant will be used to support increased High Risk Driver & Dangerous Violation Enforcement patrols in the amount of \$60,000.

This grant will be used to pay officer overtime for traffic assignments specifically targeted for enforcement of High Risk Drivers & Dangerous Violations within the Municipality of Anchorage. Through increased awareness and enforcement of High Risk Drivers and Dangerous Violations the residents of Anchorage will experience safer roads and reduced traffic accident injuries.

A special condition of the grant is that the department provides matching funds. The total projected Municipal cost is \$30,000, which has been budgeted in the 2002 Operating Budget. This grant began October 1, 2001 and end September 30, 2002.






