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

Subject: AR 2002- 77 Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the

B-3 District for a Package Store per AMC 21.40.180.D.8 for Fred Meyer, Inc.

- 1 Fred Meyer, Inc. has made application for a new conditional use permit for an
- 2 alcoholic beverages conditional use in the B-3 District for a package store per
- 3 AMC 21.40.180.D.8 for its new store on proposed Northgate Business Park
- 4 Subdivision, Tract 1D (case S-10837). This store will include grocery, retail,
- 5 package liquor store, and fuel retail.
- 6 The package liquor store comprises less than 1.5% of the total retail area, or
- 7 approximately 2,525 square feet, within the total 169,766 square feet of retail
- 8 space. The package liquor store includes a retail area, walk in cooler, and liquor
- 9 storage, containing approximately 1,800 linear feet of shelving. The package
- 10 liquor store has its own controlled entry, and will be located behind the
- 11 southwest public entrance.

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- 13 Sale of alcoholic beverages is expected to be 3% of the total sales of the main
- 14 store.
- 15 The application for the transfer of a package store license from the former Eagle
- 16 River Alaska Marketplace store will be submitted to the ABC Board.
- 17 There were seventy-five (75) public hearing notices mailed. Two were returned,
- 18 both returned undeliverable. No response to date has been received from the
- 19 Chugiak Community Council.
- 20 After review of this proposal, the Department of Health and Human Services
- 21 finds no negative comments or impacts.
- 22 Alaska Statue 04.11.410 Restriction Of Location Near Churches And Schools
- 23 provides that a package store license may not be located in a building with a
- 24 public entrance within 200 feet of a school ground or church building, measured
- 25 by the shortest pedestrian route from the outer boundaries of the school ground
- or the public entrance of the church building. Fire Lake Elementary School is
- 27 located on the tract abutting the east of the petition site, and is over 200 feet
- 28 from the proposed store. The petitioner measured the distance to the school
- 29 from the petition site, and reports that the front door of the proposed Fred Meyer
- 30 store is approximately 2,300 feet from the Fire Lake Elementary School property.
- 31 The petitioner also reports that the pedestrian route from the front door of the
- 32 proposed Fred Meyer liquor store to the front door of the Fire Lake Recreational
- 33 Center/McDonald Hockey Rink near the school is approximately 4,900 feet.
- 34 The nearest childcare center is located within Fire Lake Elementary School.
- 35 Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Child and Adult Care

Licensing Division noted that for at least the last two to three summers, Eagle

- 2 River Parks and Beautification has operated its licensed summer day camp at
- 3 this school. It is a summer program only and is for school aged children. DHHS
- 4 Child and Adult Care licensing noted that the impact of the proposed package
- 5 liquor store would appear to be minimal on these children. There are no
- 6 locational regulations in the Municipal Code.
- 7 There are no delinquent Real Property or Personal Property taxes owing for this
- 8 location.
- 9 The Anchorage Police Department investigation of licensed liquor establishments
- for Fred Meyer, Inc. reported no significant criminal history in local police files,
- and reported no incidents occurring within one year prior to date of the application.

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Within 1,000 feet of this application, there are no alcohol licenses. Within 3,000 feet of this application, there are two restaurant/eating place licenses and one beverage dispensary license.

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The license for this location is from a former liquor store that was operating in Eagle River. There are eight alcohol licenses in these two Council areas, with four package store licenses, two club licenses, one restaurant/eating place license and one beverage dispensary license, all located well north of the petition site along North Birchwood Loop, and the Old Glenn Highway both around and north of North Birchwood Loop. This equals one package store license per 1,118 residents. Approving this package store conditional use and the transfer of ownership package store license would add a fifth package store license within these Council areas, but there are no alcohol licenses within a 1,000-foot radius of the petition site.

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This conditional use for alcoholic beverages in the B-3 District for a package store generally meets the required standards of Title 21.




