A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY
APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS
(\$250,000) FROM SEIZED AND FORFEITED MONIES AWARDED FROM
CRIMINAL NARCOTICS CASES BY THE U.S. DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY,
TO THE POLICE INVESTIGATION FUND (257) FOR USE BY THE ANCHORAGE
POLICE DEPARTMENT.

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND, DOLLARS
(\$250,000) is appropriated to the Police Investigation Fund (257) from seized and forfeited
monies awarded from criminal narcotics cases by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency and the
State and Federal Courts to the Anchorage Police Department.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
approval.

Subject: Appropriation of Forfeited Monies Awarded by Drug Enforcement Agency and State and Federal Courts

The Anchorage Police Department requests appropriation of the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND, DOLLARS (\$250,000) to the Police Investigation Fund (257). This sum is from seized and forfeited monies that have been awarded to the Anchorage Police Department by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) and through state and federal judicial proceedings as a result of joint DEA and Anchorage Police narcotics interdiction operations.

The United States Attorney General is authorized under asset forfeiture provisions of the Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986, Title 21 of the United States Code, and the Tariff Act of 1930 to transfer forfeited property. The transfer must be to local law enforcement agencies that participate directly in seizure or forfeiture of the property. The Attorney General exercises final authority over the official retention and transfer of forfeited property to local law enforcement and establishes the guidelines and limitations for its use.

The Chief of Police will apply appropriated monies to police programs and activities.



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
