A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING, WHEN TENDERED, EIGHTY SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY SIX DOLLARS (\$86,556) FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY GRANT AND APPROPRIATING SAID GRANT TO MERRILL FIELD'S OPERATING FUND FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF 1209 ORCA STREET AS THE U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY HYDROLOGIC RESOURCE CENTER.

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the United States Department of the Interior Geological Survey offering the Municipality of Anchorage a grant of funds in the amount of Eighty Six Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Six Dollars (\$86,556); and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Geological Survey and the Municipality of Anchorage have a common interest in the continued use and operation of the center by U.S. Geological Survey for the purpose of conducting hydrologic data collection and hydrologic investigations focused on surface and ground water quality issues throughout the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Geological Survey and the Municipality of Anchorage share the cost in performing hydrologic studies for the Municipality resulting in a public benefit by utilizing the data from these studies to promote environmental protection and economic development within the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Geological Survey and the Municipality of Anchorage desire to enter into a Cooperative Agreement for the continued use and operation of the U.S. Geological Survey Hydrologic Resource Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Assembly of the Municipality of Anchorage:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Municipality of Anchorage hereby accepts, when tendered, the United States Department of the Interior Geological Survey Grant offer of Eighty Six Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Six Dollars (\$86,556) in the form of a Cooperative Agreement for the use and operation of 1209 Orca Street as the U.S. Geological Survey Hydrologic Resource Center for the purpose of conducting hydrologic data collection and hydrologic investigations focused on surface and ground water quality issues throughout the Municipality.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Municipality of Anchorage appropriates said grant to Merrill Field's Operating Fund.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor, or Municipal Manager, is authorized to execute an agreement with the United States Department of the Interior Geological Survey and provide information as may be required of the Municipality of Anchorage.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: The United States Department of the Interior Geological Survey has allocated Federal Funds to the Municipality of Anchorage for the continued use of 1209 Orca Street as the U.S. Geological Survey Hydrologic Resource Center.

8 Merrill Field Airport anticipates receiving a grant of Eighty Six Thousand Five Hundred Fifty 9 Six Dollars (\$86,556) in the form of a Cooperative Agreement from the United States 10 Department of the Interior Geological Survey for the use and operation of 1209 Orca Street by 11 the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS). The 1209 Orca Street facility was originally constructed 12 as a Hydrologic Resource Center and is uniquely configured for housing the USGS hydrologic 13 program for the purpose of conducting hydrologic data collection and hydrologic investigations 14 focused on surface and ground water quality issues throughout the Municipality.

The Municipality of Anchorage and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) have operated under
Cooperative Agreements for the last 15 years for use of the Municipal facility located 1209
Orca Street by the USGS to conduct hydrologic studies. USGS would again like to enter into
a new Cooperative Agreement for use of this facility.

21 Merrill Field is very supportive of utilizing the Cooperative Agreement for the use and 22 operation of the 1209 Orca Street center by the USGS. We believe this type of agreement will 23 provide additional economic benefit to the Airport and will require less administrative effort. 24 The Cooperative Agreement will provide funding to Merrill Field, in the amount of \$86,556, for 25 the 2002 annual functional cost of the 1209 Orca Street USGS Hydrologic Resource Center. 26 The period of performance of this Cooperative Agreement is from January 1, 2002 through 27 December 31, 2002, with four 12-month extension periods, through December 31, 2006, 28 Funding for any extension periods would be per mutual agreement of the parties. 29

30 Because of the diversity of environments and water related issues within the Municipality of 31 Anchorage and the State of Alaska, the USGS and the Municipality have mutual and evolving 32 interests in the acquisition and dissemination of hydrologic data and the investigations into the 33 hydrology of the area. These programs are conducted to satisfy environmental regulations 34 and studies, provide information to scientists, resource managers, planners, industry, and the 35 general public. Furthermore, as the economic center of the state, the Municipality has great 36 interest in the acquisition and dissemination of statewide resource data, which promote 37 economic development and environmental protection. 38

It is recommended that the U.S. Geological Survey grant offer be accepted, when tendered, in
the amount of \$86,556 and be appropriated to the Merrill Field Operating Budget. Acceptance
by the Assembly is contingent upon receipt of grant.
