A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PROVIDING FOR A REVISION OF THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FY 2002-2003

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly approved AO No. 2002-33 (S) relating to the FY 2002-2003 budget for the Anchorage School District on March 19, 2002, in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.05, of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the new construction or property improvements used in the computation of the Municipality's tax limitation, in accordance with Article XIV, Section 14.03, of the Municipal Charter, was revised from \$387,625,346 to \$434,497,274 allowing for \$384,350 of additional taxes in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage School District's General Fund is being decreased by \$614,306 in interest earnings due to anticipated lower interests rates; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage School District's Debt Service Fund is being increased by \$6,355,892 and the taxes are being increased by \$5,416,480 to provide for a proposed \$135M bond sale in June 2002 consisting of \$76M related to Propositions 5 and 6 approved by the qualified voters of the Municipality of Anchorage on April 2, 2002, and \$59M related to Proposition 11 approved by the qualified voters of the Municipality of Anchorage on the April 20, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage School District's Local, State, and Federal Projects Fund is being increased by \$3,000,000 to support the recent notification from the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) of additional federal grant funds; and

The taxes as originally adopted were \$137,153,752.

The increase of \$46.9M allows for an additional \$384,350 under the tax cap limitation.

bond sale in June 2002 consisting of \$76M related to Propositions 5 and 6 that

were approved by the qualified voters of the Municipality of Anchorage on the April 2, 2002 Municipal election, and \$59M related to Proposition 11 approved by the qualified voters of the Municipality of Anchorage on April 20, 1999. A portion of the bonds being sold in June has been approved for 70 percent State debt reimbursement. The State's increase in debt reimbursement for this sale is \$1,089,412. With projected lower interest rates, the interest earnings to support the Debt Service Fund have been reduced from \$210,000 to \$60,000, a reduction of \$150,000.

The FY 2002-2003 Financial Plan, as adopted, provided a budget of \$53,216,140 and \$23,164,895 in taxes for the Debt Service Fund. With the approval of AR No. 2002-107, the revised budget for the Debt Service Fund will be \$59,572,032 with \$28,581,375 in taxes.

The FY 2002-2003 Local/State/Federal Projects Fund budget, as originally adopted, provided an initial appropriation level of \$35,000,000. The District has recently been notified from the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) that the District will receive additional federal grant funds under President Bush's recently approved education plan. Therefore the District has adjusted the Local/State/Federal Projects Fund from \$35,000,000 to \$38,000,000.

The Revised FY 2002-2003 Financial Plan provides a budget level of \$354,846,135 for the General Fund, \$11,800,000 for the Food Service Fund, \$59,572,032 for the Debt Service Fund, and \$38,000,000 for the Local, State and Federal Projects Fund for a grand total of \$464,218,167. The amount of local taxes would now be \$142,954,582.

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The School Board will make the necessary adjustments to the Anchorage School District's Financial Plan upon approval of AR 2002-107 that corresponds with this memorandum.
