A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2002 ACTION PLAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, WHICH CONSTITUTES THE APPLICATION TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP GRANT AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has conducted extensive research and analysis to compile the 2002 Action Plan which is the basis upon which housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods are addressed, and

WHEREAS, the 2002 Community Development Division Annual Action Plan comprises the Municipality's application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnership Grant and Emergency Shelter Grant and identifies activities which the Municipality has elected to address the needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, the activities identified in the 2002 Annual Action Plan will, among other resources, utilize 2002 annual entitlements of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Home Investment Partnership Grant (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and

WHEREAS, throughout the development of said application and Action Plan, the Municipality of Anchorage actively sought participation of residents and representatives of lower income Anchorage neighborhoods, including community councils, and

WHEREAS, testimony was taken in a public hearing on said application and Action Plan before the Housing & Neighborhood Development Commission on March 13, and April 10, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Action Plan was endorsed by resolution of the Housing & Neighborhood Development Commission on April 10, 2002;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly Resolves:

Section 1. The Assembly adopts the 2002 Annual Action Plan as the general basis for a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods and the application for applicable federal grants.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Adoption of the 2002 Annual Action Plan of the Municipality of Anchorage.

### 1 INTRODUCTION

2  
3 The attached documentation supports AR 2002- 118, a resolution to adopt the 2002 Action  
4 Plan. The Action Plan constitutes the Municipality's application for HUD entitlement funds for  
5 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Grant (HOME),  
6 and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG).  
7

8 The Action Plan must be submitted to HUD by May 15, 2002. The plan will become effective  
9 July 1, 2002, following HUD's review and approval. The CDBG and HOME grants are managed  
10 by the Planning Department. The ESG grant is managed by the Department of Health and  
11 Human Services.

13 The Action Plan outlines an agenda of activities to be undertaken in the next year to address  
14 needs of the Municipality's lower-income residents and identifies potential resources available in  
15 the community to undertake these activities. The Action Plan was developed by the Planning  
16 Department, Community Development Division in collaboration with the Department of Health  
17 and Human Services, the Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission, the U. S.  
18 Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation, and  
19 other organizations and private citizens.

21 Consistent with federal regulations, availability of the draft 2002 Action Plan for public comment  
22 was noticed through the *Anchorage Daily News*, through posters, announcements at meetings,  
23 and electronic mailing. Written comments were accepted on the plan from March 1 through April  
24 5, and public hearings were held before the Housing and Neighborhood Development  
25 Commission on March 13, and April 10, 2002. All comments were considered in the final draft  
26 in the Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission recommendation. The final draft  
27 includes summaries of the comments received, together with responses to each comment. The  
28 2002 Action Plan is attached and recommended for adoption.
