A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATING THIRTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,300) FROM THE ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) BALANCE AND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) FROM THE EAGLE RIVER/CHUGIAK PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA FUND (162) BALANCE TO PROVIDE FOR SECURITY AT THE ANCHORAGE GRAD BLAST AND ROOM RENTAL FEE EXPENSES FOR THE CHUGIAK HIGH SCHOOL GRAD BLAST


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1: That the sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,300) is appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151) Balance to the Police Department to pay for security during the Anchorage Grad Blast.

Section 2: That the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) is appropriated from the Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation Service Area Fund (162) Balance to the Cultural and Recreational Services Department to be used as a grant to pay the room rental fees for the Chugiak High School Grad Blast.

Section 3: That this resolution is effective immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: APPROPRIATING \$1,800 TO ASSIST IN THE COSTS FOR THE 2002 GRAD BLAST EVENTS IN ANCHORAGE AND EAGLE RIVER

"Grad Blast" is a graduation party for seniors and their guests held in a drug and alcohol free environment. The 21st Grad Blast, an annual celebration for approximately 2,000 Anchorage high school students, will be held on Friday, May 31, 2002 from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. "Grad Blast" originated to provide a safe alternative for what statistics show is one of the two most dangerous nights of an adolescent's life. This event is supported by local merchants, volunteers, and the community-at-large. In past years, the Municipality has also provided support through the provision of on-site police officers.

The attached resolution, if approved, would appropriate funds to not only continue the support for the Anchorage festivities, but also provide a small contribution to assist with the room rental expense for the Chugiak High School event. The revenue source and expenditure information follows:
