approve preliminary, subsequent and revised school designs approved by the School Board.


WHEREAS, the School Board has approved the revised design submitted by Winchester

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE REVISED (SCHEMATIC) DESIGN, PHASE 3,
FOR THE EAST HIGH SCHOOL RENEWAL PROJECT

In accordance with AO NO. 2000-106(S), this memorandum provides information required for submission and approval of the revised design for Phase 3 of the East High School Renewal Project. The revised design consists of final schematic design as defined by new Municipal Code 25.25.610. This design was approved by the School Board on April 29, 2002.

The School Board approved the selection of Winchester Alaska, Inc. to be the Architect of Record on June 14, 1999, and the Assembly approved this selection on July 25, 2000 (AM 750-2000).

AO NO. 2000-106(S) requires a description of the proposed school site, school building and building program; the projected student population; the total construction budget and the funding source; the projected project schedule; and any known neighborhood impacts, comments, reactions, which reflect potential impacts of the school building on the neighboring community. These responses follow:

East High School is located on a 37-acre site in mid-town Anchorage at the intersection of East Northern Lights Boulevard and Bragaw Street. The 331,626 net square feet, two-story school facility delivers educational programs for grades nine through twelve. It was built in 1960 before Northern Lights Boulevard existed. In late 1971 the Benson Building was added as a Junior High School facility. In 1972 a cafeteria was built to serve both the High School and the Junior High School. A new gymnasium and swimming pool were added during that same time frame. The old gym was converted to the library, which was used until changed into the Commons Area in March 2002. As new Junior High Schools were built, the facility was amalgamated into a single High School. The current enrollment is 2,126, with a projected student population of approximately 2,250 for the following five school years.

The revised design is based on the Districtwide Educational Specifications for a 2,000-student body adopted by the School Board on June 8, 1998, and the project-specific Supplement to those specifications approved by the School Board on May 8, 2000.

1 On April 2, 2002, Anchorage voters approved \$1,200,000 in funding for the design of
2 Phase 3 for East High School Renewal. The construction budget for the project is
3 currently estimated at \$8,600,000. The project is presently funded for design only.

5 Construction for Phase 3 is anticipated to begin in June 2003, subject to construction
6 funding being obtained. This phase of the project is the complete renovation of the
7 auditorium and the relocation of all the performing arts classrooms, practice rooms, etc.,
8 in the same general vicinity. Work will also be done in the home economics, life skills,
9 physics, science, and deaf and hard of hearing classrooms. The counseling offices will be
10 relocated to the Benson Building. The student parking lot will be relocated to the east of
11 the gym, and the south parking lot will be modified to improve the traffic flow and
12 parking. Completion of Phase 3 construction is scheduled for the end of August 2004.

14 All Building Design Committee meetings were attended by members of ASD Facilities
15 Department and members of the East High School administration, staff, teachers, students
16 and parents. All concerns brought up at these meetings have been addressed in the
17 design, and there are no anticipated negative impacts on the school building or
18 neighboring community.
