On April 2, 2002, Anchorage voters approved \$1,200,000 in funding for the design of Phase 3 for East High School Renewal. The construction budget for the project is currently estimated at \$8,600,000. The project is presently funded for design only.

Construction for Phase 3 is anticipated to begin in June 2003, subject to construction funding being obtained. This phase of the project is the complete renovation of the auditorium and the relocation of all the performing arts classrooms, practice rooms, etc., in the same general vicinity. Work will also be done in the home economics, life skills, physics, science, and deaf and hard of hearing classrooms. The counseling offices will be relocated to the Benson Building. The student parking lot will be relocated to the east of the gym, and the south parking lot will be modified to improve the traffic flow and parking. Completion of Phase 3 construction is scheduled for the end of August 2004.

All Building Design Committee meetings were attended by members of ASD Facilities Department and members of the East High School administration, staff, teachers, students and parents. All concerns brought up at these meetings have been addressed in the design, and there are no anticipated negative impacts on the school building or neighboring community.
