A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING MAY 10, 2002 AS "POLICE MEMORIAL DAY" AND REMEMBERING AND HONORING THOSE WHO HAVE GIVEN THEIR LIVES IN THE LINE OF DUTY

WHEREAS, law enforcement duties require great sacrifices on the part of law enforcement officers and their families; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers serve the public every hour of every day of the year, and they often risk their lives to be the peacekeepers of our communities; and

WHEREAS, in Alaska, a total of 37 law enforcement officers have sacrificed their lives since statehood, of which Anchorage has lost seven officers; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2002, Alaska will observe its 14th Annual Police Memorial Day which precedes National Police Memorial Week – a time of remembrance for law enforcement officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves

Section 1: That the Assembly recognizes May 10, 2002, as "Police Memorial Day"

Section 2: That all residents are urged to pause and remember the many brave law enforcement officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
