A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REGARDING AM 391-2002 FOR THE TRANSFER OF PACKAGE STORE LICENSE TO WILLIAMS EXPRESS AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS THEREON.

WHEREAS, the Assembly considered this transfer request on April 23, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly conditioned its waiver of protest of the transfer of this license on the enactment by the Alcohol Beverage Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the North East Community Council is on record against the transfer of or establishment of any new liquor licenses in East Anchorage.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:


Section 1. To approve the transfer with the following conditions:

1. No external advertising of liquor on or in front of the building structure; and
2. No sale of single bottles of alcohol in containers less than 17 ounces.


Section 2. The Assembly does not object to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board incorporating these amendments as conditions of the license.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
