2 3 SUBJECT: Recommend the Municipality of Anchorage accept a State Farm Intersection Operational and Safety Studies Grant of One Hundred 4 5 Thousand Dollars (\$100,000). 6 7 8 The Municipality of Anchorage, Traffic Department, submitted an application to the State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company for an Intersection Operational and 9 10 Safety Studies grant. This grant offered governmental entities up to Twenty Thousand 11 Dollars for each qualified intersection study performed under the auspices of the grant. 12 All the intersections specified in the application by the Traffic Department for proposed 13 studies were deemed eligible by State Farm for a grant award. As a result, the 14 Municipal Traffic Department has been awarded a total of One Hundred Thousand 15 Dollars to conduct operational and studies of five intersections in Anchorage. 16 17 The Intersection Operational and Safety Studies will be conducted on the following 18 Anchorage intersections: (1) Lake Otis Parkway & Tudor Road, (2) New Seward 19 Highway & Fireweed Lane, (3) Old Seward Highway & Dimond Boulevard, (4) New Seward Highway & 36th Avenue, and (5) Boniface Parkway & Northern Lights 20 Boulevard.
