A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) TO THE MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (0261) FROM STATE FARM MUTUAL AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COMPANY FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, TRAFFIC DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT INTERSECTION OPERATIONAL AND SAFETY STUDIES.


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) is hereby accepted from State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company to conduct Intersection Operational and Safety Studies.

Section 2. That the sum of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) is appropriated to the Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (0261), for the Traffic Department for intersection operational and safety studies; and

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

SUBJECT: Recommend the Municipality of Anchorage accept a State Farm Intersection Operational and Safety Studies Grant of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

The Municipality of Anchorage, Traffic Department, submitted an application to the State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company for an Intersection Operational and Safety Studies grant. This grant offered governmental entities up to Twenty Thousand Dollars for each qualified intersection study performed under the auspices of the grant. All the intersections specified in the application by the Traffic Department for proposed studies were deemed eligible by State Farm for a grant award. As a result, the Municipal Traffic Department has been awarded a total of One Hundred Thousand Dollars to conduct operational and studies of five intersections in Anchorage.

The Intersection Operational and Safety Studies will be conducted on the following Anchorage intersections: (1) Lake Otis Parkway & Tudor Road, (2) New Seward Highway & Fireweed Lane, (3) Old Seward Highway & Dimond Boulevard, (4) New Seward Highway & 36th Avenue, and (5) Boniface Parkway & Northern Lights Boulevard. The objectives of the studies are to identify road engineering safety-related concerns and countermeasure strategies; provide economic evaluation of countermeasure costs/benefits; and to recommend immediate and long-term action plans for countermeasure implementation.

A grant award for the Intersection Operational and Safety Studies in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars was presented by the State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company to the Mayor on March 29, 2002.


