A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO ENTER INTO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT (TORA) IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, FOR FINANCING THE YEAR 2002 ALASKA BUS AND VAN ROADEO AND APPROPRIATING THESE FUNDS TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231).


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Public Transportation Department is authorized to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, for a sum not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for financing the year 2002 Alaska Bus and Van Roadeo.

Section 2. That these funds are appropriated to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: Authorizing a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, and the Municipality of Anchorage, Public Transportation Department, and Appropriating \$15,000 of TORA funds to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for Financing the Year 2002 Alaska Bus and Van Rodeo.

1 The purpose of this action is to seek approval for the Municipality to enter into a Transfer of
2 Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) in the amount of Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) with the
3 State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, for financing the year 2002
4 Alaska Bus and Van Rodeo. No matching funds are required.

5
6 On May 11, 2002, the Public Transportation Department will hold its annual Bus and Van Rodeo.
7 The State of Alaska has asked Anchorage's Public Transportation Department to host a statewide
8 Bus and Van Rodeo and has provided a TORA to help finance this activity. The contest rules are
9 established to conform to national rodeo standards. Winners will compete in the National Bus
10 Rodeo.

12 The State of Alaska requires Assembly authorization to enter into the Agreement. Following
13 receipt of the Assembly authorization, the State will give a final signature on the TORA. In
14 anticipation of this step, appropriation of the grant funds is incorporated into the Assembly
15 Resolution.

17 Processing of the supplemental appropriation into the Municipality's financial system will be held
18 until receipt of the actual award notification from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation
19 and Public Facilities.


